To prepare for Lisa's class, please gather the following:

- a [Basic tool kit](#) (to purchase items like these [click here](#))
- [paper piercer](#) and cork pad or foam.
- [craft knife](#) and [cutting mat](#).
- [sandpaper](#) or [sanding block](#).
- [clear drying liquid adhesive like Diamond Glaze](#).
- foam brushes.
- [acrylic paints](#).
- optional: binder for sketches and handouts.
- inks for edging ([Dew Drops](#)) and stamping ([Staz-On](#)).

I will create multiple examples each week using the following product types. I will always give you detailed supply lists of the materials I use, if you wish to re-create my projects.

- metal letters and numbers in various styles.

- coasters.

- bottle cap letters and numbers.
- icicle type letters and numbers
